

Illinois Forestry Development Council - Urban and Community Forestry Committee Chairperson

The Urban and Community Forestry Committee (UCFC) is a standing committee on the Illinois Forestry Development Council (IFDC). The UCFC is tasked with representing the interested of urban and community forestry on the IFDC and working to improve the awareness, knowledge around, and quality of urban and community forestry in the state of Illinois. The Chairperson of the UCFC is tasked with guiding the activities of the committee and presenting its work to the IFDC.

Duties:

- Serve at the principal liaison between the UCFC and the IFDC
- Attend IFDC meetings
- Attend and direct UCFC meetings
- Represent UCFC interests at IFDC meetings and vote accordingly
- Provide UCFC with reports from IFDC meetings
- With the help of the UCFC Secretary, prepare all documents for and schedule all UCFE meeting
- Work to improve the awareness, knowledge around, and quality of urban forestry in the state of Illinois
- Work to foster interest, establish standards, exchange professional ideas and pursue scientific research in Arboriculture

Requirements:

- Illinois Forestry Development Council Member
- Directly involved in urban and community forestry in the state of Illinois
- Communicate effectively: electronically (e-mail), verbally and written

Time Commitment:

- Initial 2 year term, can be confirmed for a second term
- Approximately 2-5 hours per month, plus attendance at approximately 12 meetings annually
