

## Criteria

- Junior Show: 10-17 years of age.
- Adult Show: 18 and older.

## Subject

- Artwork representative of NATIVE flora, fauna, and landscapes of North America.
- Any domesticated or exotic (zoo) animals will be disqualified.

## Material

- Canvas, paper, wood, metal, or glass.
- Medium: Charcoal, pencil, colored pencil, ink, acrylic paint, oil paint, oil pastels, watercolor paint, wood burning, stained glass, and metalwork.
- The drawing or painting must be of the artists own creation.

## Size

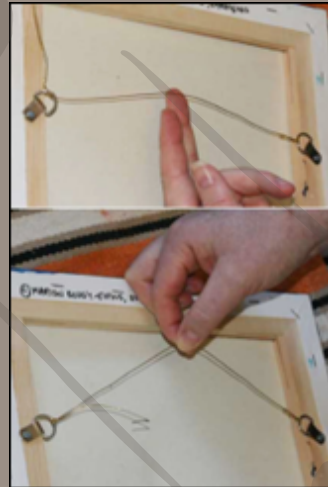
- Not to exceed 18 x 24 inches (including frame)
- Any artwork that is larger than this will be disqualified and not shown.

## Weight

- Not to exceed 5 pounds.

## Display

- Must use the option pictured here. Wire only not thread, rope, or yarn.
- Any artwork without this option of hanging will not be displayed.



## Quantity

- 3 pieces per artist.

## Attached

- Each piece must have an entry form (only the entry form itself) securely attached to the back. Waiver needs to be printed separately please and handed in.

## Contest Waiver
