# Grassland Protection Conservation Reserve Program (CRP) Incent Profession Prairie Ridge State Natural Area JAN 1 3 2004

#### Narrative

FEDERAL AID

The Jasper County Soil and Water Conservation District has provided the following services in order to promote and encourage landowners to participate in the Grassland Protection Conservation Reserve Program (CRP) Incentive payment in the Prairie Ridge State Natural Area.

In order to develop a mailing list of landowners in the priority area, a map of the Prairie Ridge priority area was completed. To build this map fifty aerial photos were pieced together to form the priority area. Then the existing CRP acreage, Prairie Ridge properties and pasture lands were identified. A list of the remaining tracts and farms was made. From this list of tract and farm numbers a database of landowner and operator names and addresses was compiled.

To inform potential landowners of the incentive payment a flyer was developed explaining the incentive payment. (See attached copy) A mailing was sent to nearly 300 landowners and or operators. From this mailing, the District received a large number of inquiries about the incentive payment. District and NRCS personnel talked with interested landowners and operators and explained the incentive payment being offered to them.

During the 26<sup>th</sup> CRP signup, landowners placed bids on 914.5 acres on twenty-nine tracts in the Prairie Ridge priority area. The incentive payment was explained to all of these landowners by staff members.

A list of every offer in the Prairie Ridge priority area was completed. A map for each of the twenty-nine bids placed was made. This information was requested by personnel at Prairie Ridge State Natural Area for reporting purposes.

Jasper County had seven tracts in the priority area accepted and Richland County had 1 tract accepted in the CRP signup. The District now has eight landowners with 100.1 acres in the priority area to work with on seeding and establishment of their CRP acres.

The SWCD staff including the AC, RC and a part-time employee along with assistance from NRCS staff has been working on this project. The following are items that will be completed in the future. Every landowner will be contacted and a list of all requirements will be agreed upon and signed by the District and the landowner. These requirements will include meeting NRCS specifications for seeding their practices and proper maintenance of each practice. Upon seeding completion, the landowner will be required to provide documentation of mixture seeded to the SWCD. A field visit (status review) by District personnel will be made to insure proper seeding and establishment of practice. After SWCD approval, payment will be made to the landowners.

The District will also require each landowner to remain in CRP for the length of their contract. If the landowner chooses to terminate the CRP contract at anytime, the \$200.00 per acre incentive payment will be returned to the SWCD, who will then return the payment to IDNR.

The District will maintain a complete record for each landowner receiving the incentive payment. Included in this will be all signed contracts, maps, seeding recommendations, status reviews, correspondence, record of payment and any other pertinent information. This documentation will be provided to IDNR upon request.

# Incentive Payment Available for CRP Grassland Establishment in Jasper County

The Jasper County Soil and Water Conservation District and Illinois Department of Natural Resources are offering an additional incentive for landowners to establish new grassland areas under the 26<sup>th</sup> CRP sign-up. The incentive is a one-time payment of **\$200.00 per acre**. This is in addition to the annual rental and cost share payments available through CRP. The purpose of the project is to provide additional habitat for declining grassland plants and animals. Most noted among these is the Greater Prairie Chicken.

To qualify for the payment, land must be:

- Successfully enrolled into CRP during the 26<sup>th</sup> CRP sign-up
- Lie within the designated incentive area in Smallwood, Fox and Wade Townships (See map on reverse side)
- 40 contiguous acres or more in size
- Planted to an approved mixture of grasses

Total enrollment for the incentive payment will be limited to just over 1700 acres in Jasper, Richland and Marion Counties. If more acres are offered for the incentive, IDNR will use the USDA CRP Environmental Benefits Index (EBI) as a tool in determining accepted acreage.

The 26<sup>th</sup> CRP sign-up is running from May 5<sup>th</sup> to May 30<sup>th</sup>. Contact the Jasper County Farm Service Agency at 618-783-2319 ext. 2 for additional information about the 26<sup>th</sup> CRP sign-up.

For additional information on the CRP incentive, contact the Jasper County Soil and Water Conservation District at 618-783-2319 ext. 3. Incentive program participants must enter into an agreement with the SWCD and IDNR to maintain the grassland cover for 10 years. IDNR biologists will work with participants to develop planting and management plans for the accepted acreage.

## Grassland Protection Conservation Reserve Program (CRP) Incentive Prairie Ridge State Natural Area

#### Project Description:

The Jasper County Soil and Water Conservation District will provide a cash incentive payment of \$200/acre for landowners enrolling 1 or more acres into the USDA Conservation Reserve Program (CRP) signup # 26 for a minimum of 10 years. These acres must lie within the boundaries of the Prairie Ridge State Natural Priority Area (as approved by IDNR).

Funding for this project will be provided through a grant from IDNR to the Jasper County Soil and Water Conservation District in the amount of \$20020.00. The SWCD will receive 80% (\$16016.00) of the funds upon execution of a contract with IDNR the remaining 20% (\$4004.00) will be paid upon request of funds by the SWCD.

The Jasper County SWCD will make the incentive payments of \$20020.00 to the landowners listed below once all obligations as required by CRP have been met.
