Project Title: Special Edition of *OutdoorIllinois* Magazine: Illinois Endangered and Threatened Species.

Project Objectives:

1. Produced an expanded issue of *OutdoorIllinois* focused on Illinois endangered and threatened species. Content was determined by committee composed of staff from *OutdoorIllinois*, the Illinois Endangered Species Protection Board (IESPB), Illinois Nature Preserves (INPC) and DNR Office of Resource Conservation. Resource experts from throughout Illinois were recruited to write articles and/or submit photographs. Once the magazine went into production, an extensive review of articles/photographs was completed by key staff to ensure biological accuracy.
2. The original target publication for January 2006 was not met due to re-evaluation of the scope of the project and need to research high-quality photographs (an opportunity to purchase unlimited rights [for DNR, IESPB and INPC] to Illinois endangered and threatened species photos taken by professional photographer Carol Freeman arose during the process; INPC acquired these images for \$5,000).
3. On January 12, 2007, distributed copies to approximately 3,750 Illinois schools having any of grades 7-12. Included a cover letter co-signed by the DNR Director and Executive Directors of the IESPB and INPC. Notice of the special edition and Web site access were sent via Educator List Serves maintained by the Division of Education.
4. Did not meet the objective of promoting the availability of a companion full-sized poster as final magazine content directed the space different than the original concept.
5. Tabulate responses received from *OutdoorIllinois* readers. Comments received to date provided on reverse. The reader survey has changed from monthly mailings to quarterly Web-based surveys. Results of the January-March survey will be available early April 2007.
6. PDF files of the articles were posted at www.dnr.state.il.us/OI on January 10, 2007 to provide Illinois educators and students access to the content. Links to the site are under way from pages maintained by DNR Education, IESPB and INPC.

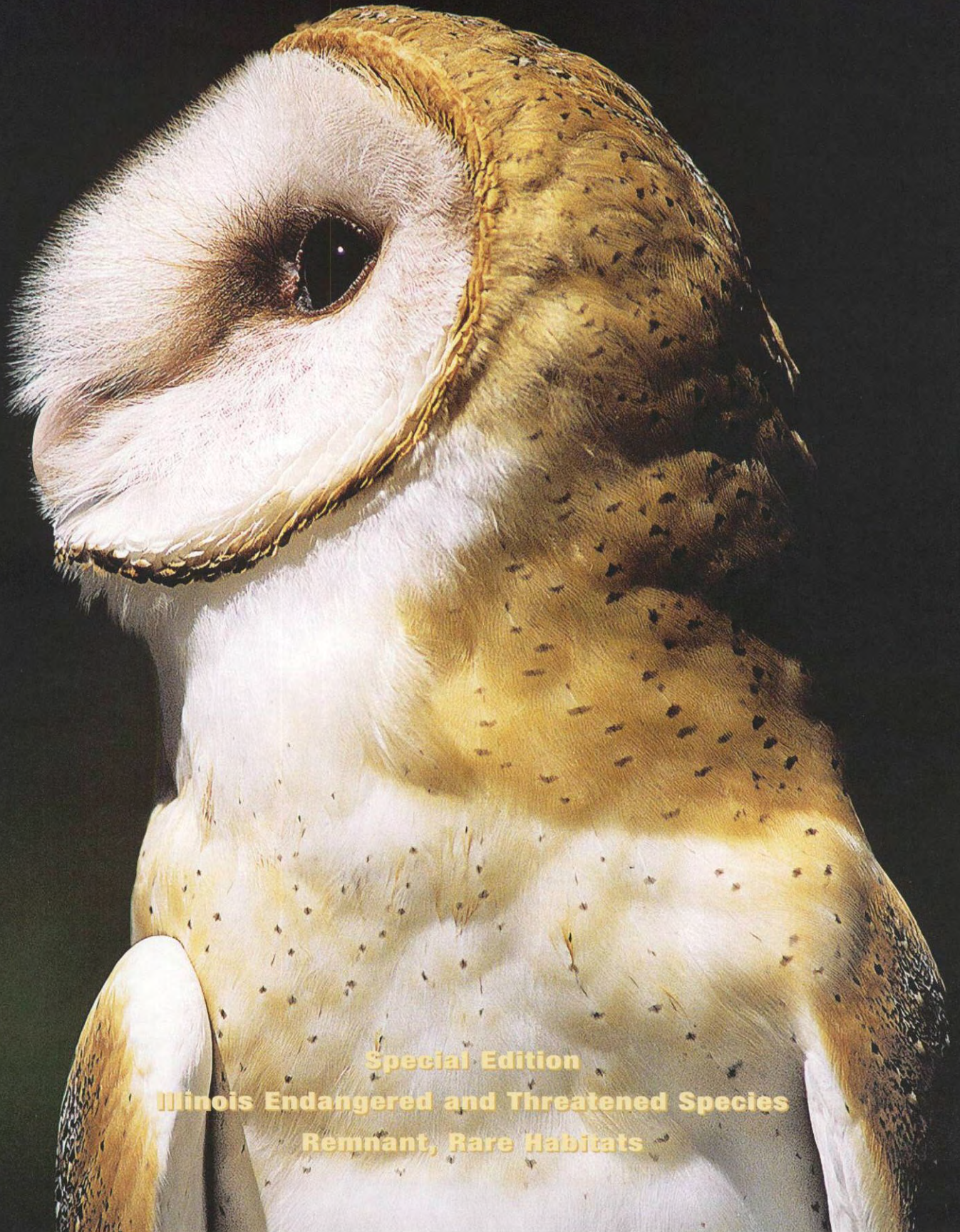
LT: **WOW!.....**What a class publication.
