**Project Title: An Island for the Birds**

**Project Narrative**

The breeding range of certain shorebird species has been reduced due to a lack of available quality nesting areas. It has become increasingly difficult for shorebird species that occur in grassland communities to find nesting areas that are not subject to rapid water level draw downs, conversion to agriculture or accessible to predators.

Recognizing that nesting island projects have proven to be successful in attracting shorebirds, terns, and gulls, the Illinois Audubon Society (IAS) constructed a site in 2003 on the Karl Bartels Wildlife Sanctuary Land and Water Reserve (part of the Prairie Ridge State Natural Area complex managed by PRSNA staff). However, it was discovered that the island was too small and would become covered with water during rain events. IAS proposed a solution to raise the elevation and install a combination of filter fabric and gravel to provide a long term nesting location that would require minimal maintenance over the long term.

Funds from this grant were used to construct a .25-acre nesting island located in the center of the existing wetland. It was shaped for level nesting areas, covered with a filter fabric and topped with 112 tons of CA-6 gravel 3-inches thick. This location will now provide a more secure nesting site for shorebird species including black-necked stilts, killdeer, spotted sandpipers, and possibly interior least terns. Native vegetation that has been established in the wetland will provide both foraging and migratory habitats for shorebirds and marsh birds.
