2. Project objective described in the application and Grant agreement:

1) Green Earth intends to purchase an enclosed cargo trailer to securely store and safely transport both habitat management gear (back pack sprayers, water drums, herbicide, weed poppers, etc.) and trail steward tools (council rakes, rogue hoes, pulaskis, shovels, etc.).

2) After obtaining trailer, a racking system will be designed, built, and installed. The trailer will then be professionally signed with the Green Earth logo and the Wildlife Preservation Fund logo to proudly advertise our organization and the Wildlife Preservation Fund.

3) This year alone, our goal is to remove 2,500 lbs of garlic mustard from an infested riparian area, herbicide spray a significant invasion of Japanese stilt grass within a 37 acre woodland and riparian corridor, and stump cut and herbicide spray both autumn olive and bush honeysuckle from areas of infestation across all six natural areas. We will also continue upgrades to three of our trails systems that include constructing water control features, revamping self-guided educational trail marker posts to two of our sites, and erecting educational signage at one of our sites. All these projects will be aided with the addition of a cargo trailer.

3. Completed project description:

Green Earth purchased a 6'x10' cargo trailer, outfitted the trailer for storing and hauling land steward tools with a rack system, and affixed 3'x6' graphics on both sides to display ownership, purpose, and WPF funding of the equipment trailer.

4. Summary of the Project accomplishments (if applicable):

This equipment trailer has been used for each Green Earth's monthly volunteer workdays to transport tools and equipment. The trailer has significantly improved the access and availability of our equipment that has aided in on-going trail maintenance and habitat management projects.

ing a problem. Executive Director Stephanie Eichholz said, "I have a small office in the SIUC Cooperative Wildlife Research Laboratory's annex building, and it was becoming dangerous. Shovels, rakes ... tons of stuff were stacked against the walls."

Eichholz applied for the IDNR's Wildlife Preservation Fund small equipment grant.

Green Earth used the \$2,000 grant to purchase a cargo trailer. Green Earth extended the funds by finding a used trailer in good shape and by recruiting a volunteer to build racks for equipment and gear.

Eichholz said Green Earth usually has 10 to 20 volunteers for each workday, but it has had as many as 100 for special projects.

The trailer will be used to transport equipment, tools and gear to volunteer workdays at the nature preserves.

Green Earth owns and manages six nature preserves in the Carbondale area that total more than 220 acres of green space.

All of the Green Earth sites are open for public enjoyment, as each site contains hiking trails. But managing 220 acres and nine miles of hiking trails takes work, not to mention lots of tools.

Construction will come in two phases, Huffman said, with the building of a showroom first and a full-service facility offering parts and service within two years.

The business will initially provide five jobs; another 15 will be added when both phases are completed, Huffman said.

The dealership will also generate sales tax revenue for the city of Benton and open up further development of commercial property owed by the EDC near the interstate, Blue Ridge purchased seven of the EDC's 34 acres at the site.

"This is the start of something we hope will blossom," incoming

EDC executive director Dave Cooper said.

Infrastructure improvements will be made to the area and construction is expected to begin sometime in the new year.

The announcement of the new business could help the two cities in their quest for a second interchange, a project now under review by the Illinois Department of Transportation and Federal Highway Administration, Huffman said.

A new interchange would improve access to the area for future development and ease traffic congestion in both cities.

Grant helps Green Earth buy trailer

Green Earth Inc., a local land conservation group, has completed finishing touches on an equipment cargo trailer obtained with the help of the Illinois Department of Natural Resources.

The trailer will be used to transport equipment, tools and gear to volunteer workdays at the nature preserves.

Green Earth owns and manages six nature preserves in the Carbondale area that total more than 220 acres of green space.

All of the Green Earth sites are open for public enjoyment, as each site contains hiking trails. But managing 220 acres and nine miles of hiking trails takes work, not to mention lots of tools.

Storing these tools was becoming a problem. Executive Director Stephanie Eichholz said, "I have a small office in the SIUC Cooperative Wildlife Research Laboratory's annex building, and it was becoming dangerous. Shovels, rakes ... tons of stuff were stacked against the walls."

Eichholz applied for the IDNR's Wildlife Preservation Fund small equipment grant.

Green Earth used the \$2,000 grant to purchase a cargo trailer. Green Earth extended the funds by finding a used trailer in good shape and by recruiting a volunteer to build racks for equipment and gear.

Eichholz said Green Earth usually has 10 to 20 volunteers for each workday, but it has had as many as 100 for special projects.
