Training and Examination

This letter is to provide notice of the next scheduled blasting licensure and certification training and examination sessions. All individuals whose duties include the direct supervision of blasting operations at surface coal and non-coal mining operations are required to be licensed or certified.

To obtain a blaster license or certificate, a person must provide an application to the Department and show proof of experience on forms provided by the Department. Applicants for Surface Aggregate licenses must submit a fingerprint based background check along with a non-refundable fee of \$150. A fingerprint vendor list can be found at https://idfprapps.illinois.gov/licenselookup/fingerprintlist.asp All required documentation must be received prior to the date of the training. Once the application is approved, the person must pass an examination administered by the Department. Training will be provided by the Department, at no charge, in conjunction with each examination.
