

Affected Acreage Submittals:

Permittees are required to submit annual affected acreage forms (SCML-3) and maps for each permit indicating the type of disturbance, amount in acres, and areas affected by mining (62 Ill. Adm. Code 1816/1817.190).

Department submittal requirements shall consist of an electronic copy, followed up with two paper copies, plus one additional copy, for each county mining operations may affect. Each submittal shall include completed SCML-3 forms for each county and an affected acreage map, if required, with proper certification. The electronic submittal(s) shall include a “.dwg” file, along with the required map files, and a “.pdf” version of the SCML-3 form and map. All submittals shall include the required information in accordance with the requirements under Sections 1816/1817.190.

Electronic documents shall be submitted **via upload to OneDrive**, and emails requesting a link to upload to OneDrive should be addressed to James.Schafer@illinois.gov. The appropriate number of paper copies should be mailed to the attention of the Land Reclamation Division supervisor.

The instructions for submitting the affected acreage documents can be found on the SCML-3 form.

Instructions:

Mined Overburden

Areas to be included in this category include all:

- all lands from which overburden has been removed.
- all areas where overburden has been deposited.
- highwall and pit areas extending to the top of the highwall.
- top of highwall slope

Surface Affected

Surface & Underground Operations	This area includes all surface areas disturbed, affected, or used in support of, or ancillary, to mining operation activities (e.g. roads, tipples, ditches, sediment control facilities, waste disposal, soil stockpile, storage areas, etc.).
Surface Mining Only	Areas extending laterally (out to the side of the direction of pit advance) which have been disturbed by soil removal and/or other soil removal, but will not be subjected to overburden removal, must be declared under the surface affected area category. Do Not Include areas where topsoil and/or subsoil have been removed in advance of the surface mining pit, unless the pit is not expected to advance.
Carbon Recovery Only	This category also includes those operations having surface mining activities which recover coal from a deposit that is not in its original geologic location, such as coal waste disposal areas (e.g. carbon recovery operations).

Reaffected Acreage

Areas previously affected by mining operations and reclaimed during a prior period, and re-affected during this period must be included in the totals on page one and indicated here:

- _____ -acres which have been re-mined during this period (Mined Overburden).
- _____ -acres which have been previously declared as support facility disturbance during the permanent program, but has now experienced overburden removal (Mined Overburden).
