- 1. - 2. Pre-exploration information is to be displayed on the quad and/or pre-exploration land use map.

Describe proposed exploration area, reference map where applicable, include: surface topography, geological, surface water, and other physical features, vegetative cover, important habitats of fish, wildlife, and plants, structures listed or eligible for listing on the National Register of Historic Places, known archaeological resources.
