SUBJECT: Sealing of application content by an Illinois Registered Professional Engineer

Several Sections under 62 Ill. Adm. Code 1700 -1850 require maps, plans and cross sections as well as other engineering related designs to be *“prepared by or under the direction of, and sealed by a qualified registered professional engineer licensed under the Professional Engineering Act of 1989 [225 ILCS 325] or a registered professional land surveyor licensed under the Illinois Professional Land Surveyor Act of 1989 [225 ILCS 330]”*.

Historically, the engineering certification form has been completed by an individual Illinois licensed professional regardless of whether or not the individual was employed by a “firm” as defined by the respective Acts cited above. In an effort to ensure compliance with the Department’s regulatory requirements, the engineering form has been revised to also address “firms” in addition to individual licensure.

Please replace the engineering form in all applications with the enclosed revised form. All future applications shall incorporate the revised form to ensure regulatory compliance.
