Re: Reporting of Affected Acreage, FY13

At this time the Department is extending the deadline for FY13 affected acreage reporting until Tuesday, December 31, 2013.

The current Affected Acreage form (SCML-3) can be found on the Department's Operator Forms and Applications web page, http://dnr.state.il.us/mines/lrd/forms.htm. All operations having areas not yet reported as affected but permitted must complete and submit an Affected Acreage form. Only those operations indicating areas affected by operations must include a map indicating the location of the areas affected, with the submittal (62 Ill. Adm. Code 1816/1817.190). Companies must submit one original signature, one copy for field files, and one copy for each county the mine is operating in. All copies must include maps, when applicable. **DO NOT** forward copies to the county Clerk's office.

Operations to be reported are: **surface affected** areas for support facilities/infrastructures and **mined overburden** for overburden placement and auger mining areas. Areas re-affected during the reporting period should be included in these totals and on page two under the Reaffected Acreage section of the form.
