Emergency Response to Environmental and

Public Health and Safety Issues

All decision documents for permits and significant revisions contain the following language as Condition E of Part IV Permit Conditions. The pertinent regulation at 62 Ill. Adm. Code 1773.17(e) requires the following:

Section 1773.17

Permit Conditions

Each permit issued by the Department shall be subject to the following conditions:

- e) The permittee shall take all possible steps to minimize any adverse impact to the environment or public health and safety resulting from noncompliance with any term or condition of the permit, including, but not limited to:
 - 1) Any accelerated or additional monitoring necessary to determine the nature and extent of noncompliance and the results of the noncompliance;
 - 2) Immediate implementation of measures necessary to comply; and
 - 3) Warning, as soon as possible after learning of such noncompliance, any person whose health and safety is in imminent danger due to the noncompliance.

Coal mine operators should establish and post contact procedures for the event of a spill, dam breach, or comparable incident that could result in the release of contamination into the environment. It is the operator's responsibility to make the appropriate contacts following an incident. These contacts should be made within 24 hours of becoming aware of the incident.

The attached table contains an example list of contacts that should be immediately notified whenever what could be an emergency situation occurs. It is recommended that permittees update the table with local phone numbers that are specific to their county or region.
