RE: Reporting of Affected Acreage Under the Surface-Mined Land Conservation and Reclamation Act as Amended, and the Surface Coal Mining Land Conservation and Reclamation Act

Enclosed are copies of affected acreage report form MLCR-3. A detailed map showing acreage affected is needed. The map accompanying the MLCR-3 must delineate the February 1, 1983, coal face, the permanent regulatory program implementation line. Either an individual map for each permit or a map showing affected acreage for all current permits at a mine is acceptable.

Affected acreage is to be delineated on the MLCR-3 and accompanying map(s) as follows:

1. Pre-February 1, 1983, affected acreage under the Surface Mined Land Conservation and Reclamation Act includes mined overburden areas and areas disturbed by mining activities which were not utilized to facilitate mining operations after February 1, 1983.
2. Post-February 1, 1983, affected acreage under the Surface Coal Mining Land Conservation and Reclamation Act includes mined overburden areas, calculated from the top of the highwall or bench to the February 1, 1983, coal face, and areas utilized to facilitate mining operations after February 1, 1983. Areas utilized to facilitate mining operations include but are not limited to access roads, haulage road, drainage control structures and systems, sedimentation ponds, preparation plants and processing areas, coal waste disposal sites, topsoil or root medium stockpiles, etc.

A form MLCR-3 and map are to be filed with the County Clerk for each surface mining permit in effect during the period from July 1, 1982, through June 1983. At the time of filing form MLCR-3, have the County Clerk sign form 3a (copies enclosed) for each MLCR-3 submitted. Please submit the completed form 3a to this office along with three copies of form MLCR-3 and three maps.

Due to the apparent lack of understanding regarding the reporting requirements for 1983 fiscal year affected acreage imposed by the implementation of the permanent Regulatory program, the deadline for submission of affected acreage reports is deferred from September 1, 1983 until October 1, 1983.

Please submit affected acreage reports and maps by October 1, 1983.

2. Mined acreage means overburden deposition areas and lands which have had the overburden removed to the mineral to be mined, and including the bench, drainage ditches under permit, and haulage roads under permit.
