Regulatory Amendments

Enclosed is a copy of the Illinois Department of Natural Resources, Office of Mines and Minerals, Land Reclamation Division's regulations codified at 62 Ill. Adm. Code 1700 - 1850. Except as discussed below, the enclosed copy contains amendments which were approved by the Office of Surface Mining (OSM) at 61 Fed. Reg. 26801-26825 (May 29, 1996).

The following regulations have not been approved by OSM:

- 1. 62 Ill. Adm. Code 1816.116/1817.116(a)(2)(F)(i) - OSM did not approve the changes to these regulations and is requiring the Department remove them from the program. Sections 1816.116/1817.116(a)(\$)(F)(ii) remain in effect.
- 62 Ill. Adm. Code 1816.116/1817.116(a)(3)(F) OSM did not approve the 2. changes to these regulations and is requiring the Department remove them from the program.
- 62 Ill. Adm. Code 1816.116/1817.116(a)(4)(A)(ii) OSM did not approve the 3. changes to these regulations and is requiring the Department remove them from the program. The following wording of these regulations is not in effect, "The Department may approve a field to represent non-contiguous areas less than or equal to four acres of the same capability if it determines that the field is representative of reclamation of such areas. These areas shall be managed and vegetated in the same manner as the representative field."

Since the above noted amendments have not been approved by OSM, they have no force or effect in Illinois even though they appear in the enclosed copy of the regulations.
