The **restored wetlands** continue to provide habitat for a variety of wetland wildlife and emergent vegetation.

Wildlife monitoring continues with the help of trail cameras, acoustic monitors, reptile coverboards, and swamp rabbit latrines.



The **restored sand prairie** is flourishing.

What's happening next:

- Continued monitoring of plant and animal communities
- Sand Prairie management
 - Seeding and prescribed burning
- Wetland, vernal pond, and timber stand enhancements
 - Water level manipulation and invasive species control
