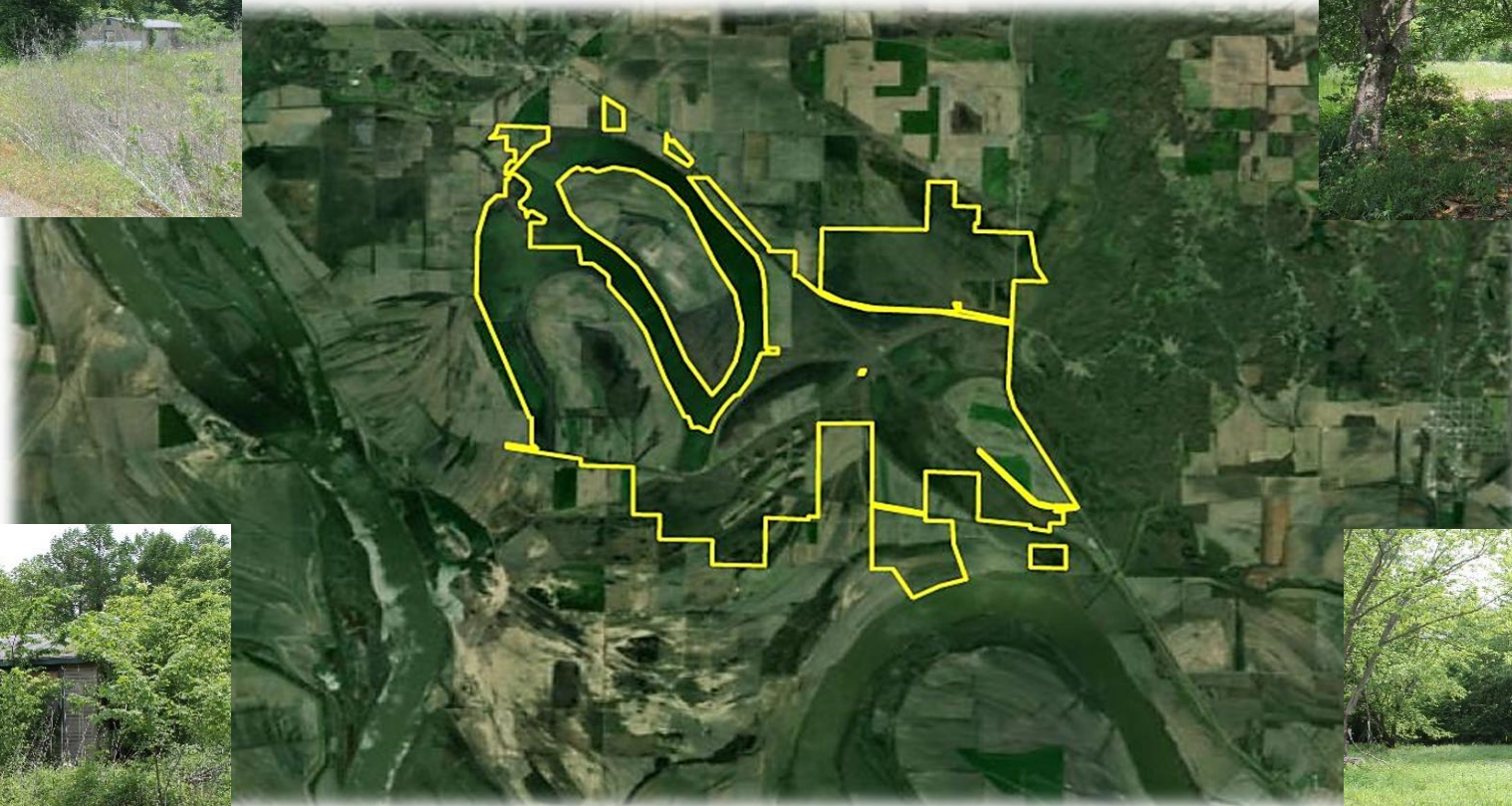

## On The Cover

On the cover are before and after photos showing parcels acquired through the Alexander County Flood Hazard Mitigation Project. This ongoing project includes acquisition and demolition of real property improved with structures affected by repetitive flooding. Participation in the project by affected property owners is voluntary, but acquisition of floodplain properties will greatly reduce the need for future federal and state disaster assistance to affected residents.

The Flood Hazard Mitigation Project is through the Department of Natural Resources, Office of Water Resources under the authority of the "Flood Control Act of 1945," 615 ILCS 15 (2004 State Bar Edition). The Illinois General Assembly appropriated funds to the Department for cost sharing to acquire flood prone structures and to implement flood hazard mitigation plans.

Working with Alexander County, IDNR continues to acquire these flood-prone properties. After acquisition, the improvements are removed creating deed-restricted open space. Expansion of public open space will provide increased natural and beneficial functions to the region. A certain few parcels adjoining Horseshoe Lake Conservation Area will be retained and managed as part of Horseshoe Lake.
