

Northeastern Illinois Regional Greenways and Trails Plan

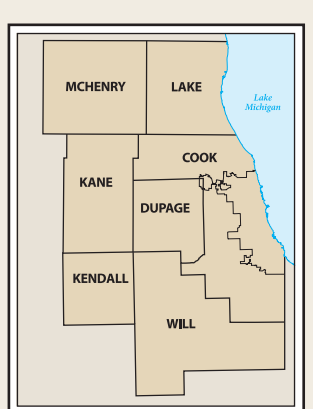
2009 Update

A large number of proposed trails are conceptual; final alignments would be determined by the jurisdiction's planning and engineering processes. Greenways on the map do not imply specific widths, design characteristics, or management approaches. These should be determined through detailed planning for the individual greenways.
