BOATING ACCIDENT REPORT - 1974

During the calendar year 1974, there were 115 reportable accidents reported to this office involving 152 boats. Seventy-eight (78) accidents involved one boat and thirty-seven (37) accidents involved two boats. Property damage amounted to approximately \$178,700.00. Thirty-four (34) accidents resulted in the drowning of 52 persons, and four accidents resulted in death, other than by drowning, to four persons.

Carterville City Lake

2/13/74: Cause unknown, boat found capsized and victim drowned, hanging on boat

Lake Michigan

3/3/74: Strong wind caused boat to capsize, 1 drowning

7/14/74: Strong wind caused boat to capsize, 1 drowning

8/11/74: Retrieving oar, fell overboard, 1 drowning

8/19/74: Tow line became tangled and skier fell, 1 drowning

Rend Lake

4/22/74: Unknown cause, boat capsized, 2 drownings

Rock River

4/6/74: Struck submerged object and capsized, 4 drownings

6/6/74: Strong wind caused boat to capsize, 1 drowning

7/7/74: Unknown cause, boat capsized, 2 drownings

8/8/74: Insecure mooring, boat went over dam, 1 drowning

8/11/74: Unknown, 1 drowning
