OTHER REPORTED CAUSES OF ACCIDENTS

victim's carelessness
 swamped by barge
 no proper lights marking harbor entrance
 other boat owner not looking out & excessive speed by other boat for conditions
 no running lights operating on other boat
 not properly tied down
 fault of operator
 inconsideration - excessive speed
 went forward instead of reversing - momentarily
 not in complete control of vessel #1
 sudden wave
 inadequate attention by #1 operator or poor lighting on barge
 submerged logs
 gas fumes built up
 a boat was making a U-turn & broadsided another boat midship on the port side
 no lights
 did not have boat under control
 submerged object
 nighttime poor visibility
 standing on water craft while underway
 stalled motor - loss of steering
 other boat captain wasn't watching where he was going
 other boat too close
 motor did not start after stopping
 abrupt change in weather
 mooring lines not properly adjusted/storm
 drag of the buoy due to high winds
 vessel was attempting to correct itself
 lack of no wake sign
 a boat was backing out of dock in front of another boat
 bridge operator error
 not understanding effects of strong current when anchored
 did not see other boat

DESCRIPTION OF ACCIDENTS RESULTING IN DROWNING *

Kaskaskia River

- 3/3/85: engine stalled, when started back up, the boat took off at full throttle, boat capsized - 2 drownings
7/28/85: three men were fishing, two of their hats blew off, as they turned the boat around, the boat overturned - 1 drowning

Stripper Pit

- 4/3/85: canoe overturned when someone tried to climb in - 1 drowning

East Fork Bolder

- 4/16/85 two teenagers were in a boat, one of them started splashing water & rocking the boat, the boat began to take on water & eventually sank, one person was rescued from an observer on shore - 1 drowning

Rend Lake

- 4/21/85 boat bumped into a tree, 1 fell overboard - 1 drowning

Lake Story

- 5/13/85 a man was fishing from a standing position, when he sat down, the seat pedestal broke, he fell overboard - 1 drowning

Lake Michigan

- 5/26/85 caught in storm, victim fell overboard - 1 drowning
6/8/85 a man disappeared while taking his new boat out for a test run, no additional information is known in regard to the accident - 1 drowning
6/27/85 collision w/barge - 2 drownings
10/4/85 boat exploded & sunk - 1 drowning

Lake of the Woods

- 6/3/85 two boys in a paddle boat were having a "water fight" with two boys in a row boat, one of the boys in the paddle boat leaned from the boat, lost his balance, and fell from the boat hitting his head on the row boat. The boy did not struggle in the water and appeared to be "knocked out" - 1 drowning

Fox Lake

- 6/9/85 while attempting to assist a friend who had begun to struggle while putting on his water skis, a man drowned in the confusion - 1 drowning

Dresden Lakes

- 6/29/85 while making a sharp turn, the operator fell overboard - 1 drowning

Kankakee River

- 7/5/85 three men were canoeing, the men were apparently rocking the canoe before it overturned - 1 drowning

Lake Miltmore

7/5/85 three men had been rowing a small boat, 1 man apparently fell or jumped in the water, the other two men jumped in to get him causing the boat to overturn, one man was saved by two teenagers who were near the scene of the accident - 2 drownings

Illinois River

7/20/85 boat capsized, thrown overboard - 1 drowning
10/24/85 man fell overboard - 1 drowning

Pecatonica River

7/12/85 installing an anti-theft bar on boat, fell overboard - 1 drowning

Mississippi River

7/16/85 1 drowning - cause of accident unknown

A Private Lake

8/25/85 stood up in boat, causing boat to sink - 1 drowning

YMCA Lake

8/25/85 boat overturned - 1 drowning

Green River

8/27/85 went fishing in the morning, body was found in the afternoon cause of accident unknown - 1 drowning

ACCIDENTS RESULTING IN DEATH FROM INJURIES *

Illinois River

7/6/85 collision w/vessel, thrown overboard - 1 death from injuries

Carlyle Lake

7/10/85 boat struck a submerged object, occupants fell overboard - 1 death from injuries

Rock River

7/23/85 steering cable broke, occupants thrown overboard while trying to gain control of craft - 1 death from injuries

Unknown River (Incomplete accident information)

7/25/85 cause of accident unknown - 1 death from injuries
8/8/85 throttle stuck on boat causing driver to lose control - 1 death from injuries
