
## **PUBLIC NOTICE**

## MODIFICATION OF AN EXISTING BARGE TERMINAL IN THE MISSISSIPPI RIVER (APPROXIMATELY BETWEEN RIVER MILES 176.1 AND 176.7) IN ST. CLAIR COUNTY

Notice is hereby given to all interested parties that the Illinois Department of Natural Resources, Office of Water Resources (IDNR/OWR) has received an application for permit from Consolidated Grain and Barge Company, #3 Cargill Elevator Road, Cahokia, Illinois 62201 to modify an existing barge terminal in the Mississippi River in St. Clair County. A location map is provided on the second page of this notice.

The proposed modification is located immediately upstream of an existing loadout cell and conveyor. The project includes two new monopile dolphins and replacing an existing work barge with a new work barge. This new barge would maintain the berthing line upstream of the loadout cell. The two proposed monopile dolphins are on the landward side of the new barge between it and the left-descending bank. Each proposed monopile is approximately 6 ft. diameter. The work is roughly parallel to the left-descending bank and is between the existing loading cell and an existing sheet pile cell.
